Your role makes all the difference



Your role as a **homeowner**

Whether you are raising a family, living with a partner or flying solo, you have the responsibility to ensure your gas appliances are annually checked by a Gas Safe registered engineer.



Your role as a **landlord**

You have a legal responsibility to ensure the safety of your tenants by making sure all gas appliances are safety checked annually, and that your tenants are provided a record of this check.



Your role as a **caretaker**

Are you responsible for taking care of relatives or friends? Encouraging safety checks and looking out for warning signs of unsafe gas appliances, such as dark sooty stains around the boiler, lazy yellow flames on the hob, or blocked vents, helps keep your loved ones safe.



Your role as a **parent or guardian**

Have your kids left home, moved to university or going on holiday? Ensuring they are geared up on gas safety knowledge and that they own, use, and regularly test an audible carbon monoxide alarm no matter where they are, will help keep them gas safe outside the nest.

Your responsibilities may differ, but everyone has an impact on keeping the nation gas safe.
