What can go wrong?

If a large amount of gas escapes from a tampered meter and builds up in the air throughout the building, it could lead to a powerful and devastating explosion.

Gas fumes displace the air in a room and can cause headaches and loss of consciousness. Leaking gas is also highly flammable, and could cause a fire at the flick of a light switch.

What to look out for:



Back to front meter



Rubber piping or hoses attached to the meter



Smell of gas around or near to the meter



Meter dials not working or the digital display is blank



Meter is working but showing no credit



Meter dial has disappeared
