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Foreword

Metering Charging Statement 1 April 2020

This booklet sets out the metering charges that Cadent will apply for services provided under the Uniform Network Code from 1 April 2020

The diagram below shows Cadent's operational areas



Some of Cadent's metering charges are regulated by a price control set by Ofgem, the gas industry regulator. Ofgem has set tariff caps for four key metering and meter reading services.

Cadent's charges for these services must not exceed the tariff caps. The tariff caps change each year by inflation in accordance with Special Condition 4D of Cadent's licence

2. Charges from 1 April 2020

2.1 Introduction

This section sets out the charges for the Uniform Network Code and Cadent's Metering Contracts. This document does not override or vary any of the statutory, licence or Uniform Network Code or other contractual obligations upon Cadent.

2.1.1 Data loggers - Daily Metered Sites - asset charge

Datalogger charges	Pence Per Day	£ Per Annum

Provision -	273.5674	£998.52
Installation	14.5192	£53.00
Maintenance	12.6376	£46.13

Data logger charges apply to all data loggers at daily metered supply points, as defined by the Uniform Network Code.

2.1.2 Prime and sub-deduct charges

Charges for the provision of meter reading services to Shippers for meters in sub-deduct arrangements

Provision of meter reading services to shippers for meters at Sub-Deduct Arrangements as defined in Uniform Network Code (UNC) Transportation Principle Document (TPD) Section G1.8. Invoice arrangements for such reads are managed through Xoserve on behalf of Gas Transporters in accordance with UNC TPD Section S arrangements.

(N.B NO7 I&C Non Monthly Read and NO8 I&C Opening Read have been excluded from this charging statement as they have been removed from the UNC and therefore not applicable here).



3. Metering Charging Methodology

3.1 Introduction

In addition to publishing charges, Cadent's Gas Transporter Licence requires us to publish an explanation of the methods by which, and the principles on which, our charges are calculated.

Ofgem has set tariff caps for four key services. Cadent's charges for these services must not exceed the tariff caps, which are changed each year by inflation calculated in accordance with the methodology set out in Cadent's GT licence.

As Cadent no longer owns domestic meters only the DM Daily Meter Read charge is relevant.

3.2 Metering Tariff Caps from 1st April 2020

Service Tariff Cap - DM Daily Meter Reading

3.3 Within Day Monthly Charge

Charge for provision of within-day reads from Dataloggers

This charge is made for those Shippers that receive this service during the month irrespective of the number of MPRNs and days for which the service is received.

Within Day Monthly Charge £20.01





4. Must Read Charging Methodology

4.1 Introduction

The provision of meter reading services to shippers where the shipper has failed to provide a read within a defined period as detailed in the Uniform Network Code (UNC) Transportation Principle Document (TPD) Section M. Cadent will use reasonable endeavours to obtain a reading in these circumstances. Invoice arrangements for such reads are managed through Xoserve on behalf of Gas Transporters in accordance with UNC TPD Section S arrangements.

4.2 Must Read Pricing Information from 1st April 2020

Must Read	One cold call visit within 5 working days. 3x Cold call visits within 10 Working Days. Letter sent to consumer specifying timed appointments to take place within a 5 Working Day window.	£86.21
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These rates exclude the Xoserve service charges which are charged separately.
