'Unsafe and dangerous' site of former pub reduced to rubble overnight

A FORMER Kendal pub earmarked to be converted into luxury apartments has been reduced to rubble over safety fears

Westmorland and Furness Council served a dangerous structure notice on properties 133 to 139 Stricklandgate,

which was previously the Sawyers Arms. A council spokesman said: "The building has unfortu-nately deteriorated to the point where it is considered to be an immediate safety risk to be an immediate safety risk and causing danger to the public and therefore requires demolition."

An emergency road closure was in place from 7.30pm on Tuesday to 3am on Wednes-day, which included a short suspension to the one-way system on Stricklandgate, Highgate and Kirkland. The **Continues on Page 7**

DONALD Campbell's recordbreaking hydroplane Bluebird K7 is returning to its spiritual Lake District home.

After years of legal wrangles it is to return to Coniston and go on hydroplane in permanent display in the Ruskin Museum. which he met his end in 1967

Bluebird is

Campbell died aged 45 on January 4 1967 when Bluebird flipped into the air and disintegrated as he attempted a new water speed

record on Coniston Water. In 2001 Campbell's body and the wreckage of Bluebird were recovered from the depths of the lake and he was buried later that year in the village.

Campbell's family gave Blue-bird as a gift to the Ruskin Mu-

seum in the village which his daughter Gina (above) described in 2006 as his "spiritual home". However, the vessel has been at

the centre of a dispute involving North Shields-based engineer Bill Smith, who recovered the wreckage. Now the museum says it has finally managed to secure its fu-

ture.
